Equestrian Section - Rules and Regulations

Motueka A&P Association ("the Association")

- Current R.A.S. height certificate and performance cards must be carried. Measuring at Nelson show grounds is available prior to Nelson show. Temporary Measuring certificates will not be available this year.

To be read in conjunction with the rules and conditions outlined in their respective sections, and the Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ and their Affiliated Associates. In particular, all Exhibitors and Competitors should make themselves familiar with the General Rules section GR 1 to GR 7 of Equestrian Rules for RAS Affiliated Shows/Events which is available to download on www.ras.org.nz.

These rules relate to Rules, Infringements, Conduct, Hats and Safety Helmets, Saddlery and Accessories, Abuse of Exhibits and Temporary Pens.

The Association holds records of names and addresses of all Members and Exhibitors and may publish these for the purposes of show media reports or promotional purposes at the Association's discretion. The Association may take photographs and video images of Members, Exhibitors and Exhibits and the employees, agents and assistants of any Exhibitor and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media at the Association's discretion.

1. All persons entering the grounds must comply with the Health, Safety & Employment Act 2015 and subsequent amendments.
2. The Association will not under any circumstances be held responsible for loss, damage or miss-delivery of any stock, implement or other exhibits of any description exhibited at the show. Entrants for any events, classes or competitions who exhibit, compete or participate therein do so entirely at their own risk in every respect and neither the Association nor any officer, agent or employee of the Association shall be in any way responsible for any loss, injury, damage or casualty whatsoever.
3. All entries must be made in writing to the Show Organiser on or before the closing date published and must be made in the name of the bona fide owner of the exhibit. Fees must be paid at the time of entry – NO ENTRY WILL BE VALID UNLESS THESE CONDITIONS ARE COMPLIED WITH.
4. Refunds of up to 75% of entry fees may be paid at the discretion of the Committee of the Motueka A & P Association upon receipt of a veterinary or doctor's certificate accompanying a written explanation as to the reason for the request. Any request for a refund must be made within seven days following the show – no refunds will be accepted after this time.
5. All persons admitted to the show shall be subject to the rules and orders of the committee and admittance may be refused to any person who has not paid the correct fee or who does not hold a pass of admittance.
6. All protests must be made in writing and lodged with the secretary either before or after the judges have proceeded to their duties. Any exhibitor entering a protest must deposit \$50.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. If the protest is lodged before the judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the exhibitor. If after that the onus of proof will rest with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than 30 minutes after the prize tickets are affixed. The Committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable and there should be no appeal from their decision.
7. HATS and SAFETY HELMETS
 - a. In all cases current WorkSafe New Zealand rules prevail.
 - b. A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, a bowler, protective headwear or a safety helmet.
 - c. Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling, or riding for any other reason an exhibit at an RAS affiliated Show/Event or in any area considered to be for whatever reason a part of the Showgrounds.
 - d. All riders, including harness drivers with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds. Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz-equestrian>. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook
8. Age of all horses to be determined from 1st August. Exhibits under three years of age are not permitted in any ridden or driven class no matter what the rules of any affiliated Breed Society or Kindred Society may prescribe
9. A Novice is a horse or pony which has yet to win six first places in conformation classes at any A & P show as at the time of the show. Number of wins is counted at time of show not time of entry. Once a Novice has had six wins it is not eligible for Novice classes. If a Novice entry has gained six wins by the day of the show, the competitor must advise the Show office and may change to an Open class within the same section or if no class remains to enter, a refund will be actioned after the Show. Novice classes are open to riders of any age. Refer Rule CDE 6 of Equestrian Rules for RAS Affiliated Shows/Events.
10. AGE OF RIDERS & HANDLERS - Open ponies must be ridden by riders under 17 years of age. All riders must however enter the correct riding class in accordance with their age as at 1 August 2018
 - a. Rider/Handler's age and eligibility is determined as per the 1 August i.e. Riders/handlers who are of age for any division/section on the 1 August complete the show year/ season in that division/section. Proof of age may be required and should be on hand.
 - b. Lead Rein classes are restricted to riders under eight (8) years of age with a minimum age of four (4) years, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/Event. To be Lead by an attendant fourteen (14) years of age or over.
 - c. First Ridden classes are restricted to riders under ten (10) years of age, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/Event.
 - d. novice pony exhibits (except Novice Pony Stallions) may be ridden by a rider of any age, in novice pony classes only.
 - e. Novice pony stallions must be Lead or ridden by a rider fourteen (14) years and over.
 - f. Open pony exhibits must be ridden by riders under seventeen (17) years of age.
 - g. Open pony stallions must be ridden by a rider fourteen (14), or fifteen (15), or sixteen (16) years of age, Lead handlers must be fourteen (14) years and over.
 - h. Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be twelve (12) years and over.
11. Stallions and Colts: Refer Rule CDE 14 of Equestrian Rules for RAS Affiliated Shows/Events. All Stallions and Colts must be shown in a bit with the exception of Foals and Miniature Horses, and Shetland Pony Yearlings. In the case of Miniature Donkey Jacks 86cm and under, they

must be either shown in a bit or a halter with a stallion chain. A Steward will order any Stallion or Colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the Stallion/Colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor. It is compulsory for all Stallions and Colts, excluding foals, to wear two official "S" identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle at all shows/events at all times. The handler/rider must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. "S" badges to be purchased prior to the show from RAS head office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS head office. Handlers must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at shows when outside the showing ring. Vests to be purchased prior to the show from RAS head office.

12. **YELLOW CARD** – this show supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system. A Yellow Card will be issued in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated show/event/registered measuring stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the person responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website: www.ras.org.nz.
13. **Clean Sport** – The Rules of the Royal A & P Society of New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible risk. **Forbidden Substance** – any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its actions upon the central or peripheral nervous system or in the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.
14. **ARREARS** – No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.
15. **Summary of RAS Resolution Process** – the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner
16. Yards are allocated according to entry forms, and subject to the discretion of the committee. Persons found abusing this system will be the subject of the disciplinary procedures as outlined in the rules, regulations and guidelines of the RAS and Motueka A&P Association.
17. The Honorary Vet for Motueka A&P Show is The Vet Centre Motueka, 03-528 8459 (All accounts are the responsibility of the exhibitor/owner).
18. Any person not having a Gate Pass will be charged Gate Entry on Sunday 3rd December 2017, including Competitors and Owners. Members are sent 1 Gate Pass upon receipt of membership subscriptions. Further passes are available \$5 Adult or child, children in car-seats are free.
19. Please note: Due to space constrictions, overnight camping will be kept to the area behind the new yards. Once this is full, the A&P Committee will direct an overflow area.
20. On Sunday 3 December 2018, Floats and Horse-trucks must only enter/exit through the College Street entrance. Parking will be from College Street.
21. District Horse/Pony Classes: Open to all riders and Horses within the Show Boundary, defined as that area bound by Stanley Brook Hill, Takaka Hill, Mapua, Dovedale and Moutere Hill

Show Jumping

22. Registration is needed to compete in all SJ/SH classes, at all A & P and ESNZ Shows. Introductory registration is available for introductory classes for Hack and Ponies at a levy of \$10 per day. Those jumping in Open classes must have a rider registration or full equine registration with ESNZ. <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/disciplines/jumping-show-hunter/>
23. Show Jumping Champions from Open classes only. Points awarded 1st 10pts, 2nd 9pts, etc. All complete rounds get at least 1 point. In the event of a tie, the Champion will go to the tied combination with the most 1sts from the contributing classes.
24. Show Jumping is run under ESNZ rules. However, Motueka A & P and RAS rules have precedence where there is a conflict of rule
